BACKGROUND DETAILS

The city of Tamara and the province of Casanare have a historical and a personal meaning. Historically Casanare provided freedom fighters to the independence cause. Famously called "Lanceros" for the ability with the spears and horse back riding. During the last and most important battle the "Lanceros" gave the final assault to the Spanish forces to win the independence of Colombia. That was on August 7th, 1810. There is a police force with the honor to carry the name "Lanceros"

Personally, the person who was to become my second father was born in Tamara.





Tamara has been an isolated region from the main areas of the country. Again, the coffee growers of Casanare keeping their fighting spirit continue to thrive in the coffee industry. We are proud to present this coffee to you.

The small coffee producers pick and process their coffee at their own micro-wet mills and then dry their own coffee, typically on elevated tables inside solar dryers that provide protection from the rain. Their cooperative although small has an strict protocol to produce high quality coffee.
