ORIGIN INFORMATION

Grower Coffee producers organized through Subak Abian (SA) a traditional structure of farmer organization in upland Bali
Variety Bourbon, (S795 & USDA 762) Typica, and Catimor
Region Kintamani Highlands of Central Bali, Indonesia
Harvest May - October
Altitude 1200 – 1600 meters
Soil Volcanic loam
Process Hand picked, wet-hulled, two-step sun drying on raised beds
Certifications Organic, Rainforest

BACKGROUND DETAILS

BALI ORGANIC RFA BLUE MOON GRAINPRO is sourced from family owned farms located in the Kintamani highlands on the island province of Bali, Indonesia. Coffee is grown in the volcanic soils of Mount Agung along with citrus trees that provide shade and another source of income. Coffee production is typically organized around a Subak Abian, which refers to the ecologically sustainable irrigation systems developed more than 1,000 years ago by Hindu priest who practice Tri Hita Karana (the three sources of prosperity), a philosophy focused on the harmonization between the environment, humans and God.
